



#### **US Corn Utilization**



#### **US Corn Used in Ethanol**



#### U.S. Ethanol Biorefinery Locations






- The U.S. ethanol plant total is 118 with installed capacity of 5.624 billion gallons.
- There are 62 plants under construction with expected capacity of 4.588 billion gallons. Total of 10.2 billion gallons by 2007 2008.


### U.S. Ethanol Industry Needs BBI

- Sustained government support


## US Projections E85 Ethanol Demand
